Invocation by Smt. Harini. The Mandaym Srivaishnava Sabha celebrated Acharya Ramanuja's Thirunakshattiram on Sunday, the 1st June 2008 at Sri Ramanuja Samskriti Bhavana, Sampige Road, Malleswaram. Nearly 450 members participated and got the blessings of Udeyavar.

The programme started at 9.30 am with procession of Lord Sri Ranganatha with Ubhaya Nachiyars and Sri Ramanuja on a well decorated peetam carried by members from Samskriti Bhavana to Sri Yadugiri Yathiraja Mutt. Veda Parayana Gosti and Goda Gosti enchanted "Yathiraja Vimshatihi" in the procession. After Shathumurai and Theertha Prasadam in Narasimhar Sannidhi, the procession came back to Samskriti Bhavana where Nadaswaram was played and the Anand Jai Kishan Hall created a temple atmosphere.

The Invocation song "Shrimannarayana" in the raag Bhouli sung by Smt. Harini M.N. Sridhar was very apt to the occasion and invoked - everyone to the programme.

Sri M. D. Ramanuja, President of the Sabha welcomed the members and spoke about the importance of the celebration. He requested the members to come in large numbers on time and help the organisers to go through the programme as scheduled and encourage the artists by their participation and support.

He said "from historic perspective, life of Sri Ramanuja has many facets. After descending to earth as an avatar of Adishesha, he synthesised the essence of Alwars and Acharyas messages into Vishistadwaita philosophy. Apart from propogating Srivaishnavism and reinstalling Tirunarayana at Melkote, he built more Narayana temples at Talakkad, Gadag, Belur, Tondanur, through which he exhibited his great

organising skills with the goal of promoting Srivaishnavism. His engineering skills can be seen in the construction of 'Moti Talab' in Tondanur that provides water supply. His greatest asset of Catholicity can be seen when he allowed 'Chandalas' who assisted in temple building into temple shrine. Similarly when he deserved to eat the remains of food partaken by Kanchi Poorna. The presence of 'Bibi Nachiyar' shows the enormous breadth of vision in respecting all religions. His love for downtrodden cannot be matched by any. Devotees were always in his heart. When he was about to leave Melkote, people demanded that he should not leave the place. His love for them resulted in a sculpting of a replica of himself, in stone and assuring the devotees that he is always present in the Vigraha, by injecting a spark of his ownself. There are many incidents in the history of Ramanuja's life. It is a great inspiratio to every Shrivaishnava.

Kum. M. A. Seetha, Vice-President of the Sabha briefed the audience to recollect about the life history of Udeyavar highlighting the achievements in spreading Vishishtadvaita and his contributions in Prabhandhas. She presented a short introduction to the play "Sri Ramanuja Vaibhavam" written and directed by M. A. Kuntala.

"Anupama Mandya (Nagamangala family), wife of Nagaraj Mandya (Kanchi family), participated in the 30th anniversary of the prestigious San Francisco Ethnic Dance Festival. This festival is conducted every year in June in the Palace of Fine Arts

auditorium in San Francisco, California, USA. Auditions are held to select dancers in which over 700 dancers participate out of which 20 teams are selected to represent ethnic dance forms from all over the world. Anupama and her group represented Bharatanatyam from India. Titled "Poorthi", Anupama's troupe presented a tillana in Kapi raga and depicted a story from the life of Queen Shantala Devi of the Hoysala dynasty related to the Belur Chennakeshava temple. The dance was appreciated by the huge audience of over 1000 people.

Both Anupama and her husband Nagaraj are very active in the Indian classical music and dance community of the California bay area. Nagaraj is a popular violinist in that area and plays numerous concerts regularly accompanying both local artists and artists visiting from India. Nagaraj plays concerts regularly on local TV channels in USA. Nagaraj was also interviewed for a documentary made by the National University of USA on how immigrants to the USA retain their native culture. Nagaraj also teaches violin in the bay area."

GOOD TO FORGIVE, BEST TO FORGET.

A CENTENARY YEAR REMEMBERANCE Sri Srinivasa Shadagopa Sharma



Sri Srinivasa Shadagopa Sharma, very popularly known as S.S. Sharma was a doyen of our Mandayam community. He is very affectionately remembered by many people who were associated with him in all walks of his life. His character, honesty, punctuality and perfection in work made him an admirable person.

Sri S.S. Sharma was born in Melkote in the year 1909. He was the son of Sri M.A. Rangachar and Smt. Srirangamma. He was from the great lineage of Anandampillai of Tirumala. He was the grandson of Sri Alwar Tirumalai Iyengar Swamy, from whom he inherited the qualities of generosity and love towards Lord Srinivasa, which made him to visit Tirumala often. He visited Tirumala to have the darshan of the Lord Srinivasa, every two months, this showed his immense faith and love towards the deity. He has three sons and four daughters. He had named his house as **"SRI RANGA RANGA" (SriRanga**mma-**Ranga**char) in memory of his parents.

As a Civil Engineer, he was famous for the quality of work, which he had constructed throughout South India. Early in his career, he constructed Lokapavani Bridge, Cotton Mills in Adoni, and Bellary, Woodlands Hotel in Bangalore & Chennai and has also constructed many houses in Bangalore. The big factories like VST Tillers at Whitefield, Mysore Electrical Industries at Yeshwanthpur are the glorifying works of his, even today. He also built the Vivekollasini Sabha at Melkote.

Sri Sharma enjoyed being a Consultant Engineer for many Temples, like Vijaya Vittala, Mahalakshmi Mandir at Lower Palace Orchards, Sri Venugopala Swamy Temple and Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Temple both at Malleswaram. He was also a Dharmadarshi for few years at the Venugopalaswamy Temple. The Jeeyangars of Tirumala Yethiraja Mutt had very high regard for him and used to consult him for all the engineering activity at all their mutts. Sri Sharma used to thoroughly enjoy the distribution of Tirumala Prasadams to all the known persons after his every visit.

He had a good relationship with the Yethiraja Mutt Jeeyars of Tirumala. Even today they feel happy when Sri Sharma's children, grand children and great grand children visit Tirumala.

Sri Sharma married Smt. Vedavalli, who was also from Melkote. She lived according to the word of Sahadarmacharini. Sri Sharma's wife was a very nice, good looking and an excellent person and she stood by Sri Sharma in all his actions. They both had a very good understanding between them and they lived for 67 long married years. Both of them started their day by listening to the devotional songs in their well designed pooja room. They taught Music ande Pasharams to their sons, daughters and also to their grand children. They were very affectionate to their children, sons-in-law, daughters-in-law, grand children and great grand children. He and his wife loved to perform all festivals in grand manner. They were always insisting that all their family members should chant the "Sriguna Rathna Kosham Shlokam" and that too on the Friday evening pooja. In their house, the Friday evening poojas were the days to be remembered. Even today, that tradition of Friday evening pooja is celebrated in their children, grand children and great grand children's house.

Sri Sharma's eldest son, Sri Rangarajan was awarded "Eminent Mandayam" for his contribution as an engineer to the buildings of Sri Yathiraja Mutt at Malleswaram. He was also awarded the "Eminent Civil Engineer" from the Torsteel Research Foundation of India in the year 2004. Sri Narasimharajan is the second son of Sharma and was the captain of the Indian Basketball team. He is also a structural engineer by profession and lives in USA. Sri Rangarajan was a Basketball player too, both the brothers are very well known sports persons in our community and both played for the then Mysore State team. Sri Sharma himself was a hockey and football player and he encouraged sports in his family. His third son Sri Ramgopal, who has won many championship trophies in Billiards and Snooker, is a Principal Research Scientist in Indian Institute of Science. He has won many awards and also the prestigious Presidential award in the area of scientific research.

The four daughters of Sri Sharma are good singers in Carnatic music.

GOOD WORDS CAN COOL EVEN A ROBBER, WHO HAS COME TO ROB YOU.

Sri Sharma's grandchildren are all well educated and are employed in private, national and multinational companies and are all shining very well in their activities.

Sri Sharma was an ardent lover of Literature and Carnatic music and his favorite singer was M.S. Subbulakshmi. He had good collection of books at his house, were were of religious, music, philanthropic, and he used to read these books everyday amongst his busy schedules.

Sri Sharma was the president of Vivekollasini Sabha, Ubhaya Vedantha Sabha for many years. He was awarded the **"Veda Dharmasaktha"** by the "Veda Dharma Paripalana Sabha". As the president of the Vivekollasini Sabha, he insisted that Sri Ramanuja's Thirunaksatram should be celebrated on a grand scale at Melkote every year. He was also honored at the Ubhaya Vedantha Sabha during his 80th birthday.

In fact, his 80th birthday which was very grand to be remembered even today, both the Jeeyangar Swamis from Tirumala had come to his house and blessed him with all prasadams, pavitram, garlands, etc. On the occasion, even representatives from Melkote, Srirangam came to the function with all prasadams, which he loved immensely. He always used to say that all persons should do the **"Bhagavatha Kainkaryam"**, and this was his motto in his life.

Sri Sharma lived for 87 years (1996), which was very fulfilling. he proved that hard work, good thoughts, honesty, devotion in God and helping others will make a person always **"memorable and eternal"**.

He is a person to be "remembered always" M. G. Venkatesh

Mathre Doreswamy Iyengar (1908-1983)



Mathre Doreswamy Iyengar, youngest son of Mathre Srinivasa Iyengar and Mathre Shingamma, was born in 1908, at Cuddalore in Tamilnadu (where his father was in service). He lost his father at a very yong age of 5 years. He had his early school education at Melkote, and higher education in Bangalore. He did Civil Engineering degree from Government Engineering College (now Vishweswariah Engineering College) in the year 1928 or so. As in those days getting a government job as a supervisor (at a salary of Rs. 50/-) was difficult, he started his Civil Engineering contract firm "D.I. Mathre & Co" at Mysore. His shop at Lansdown buildings at Mysore was a landmark.

He married Smt. Janakamma, daughter of Sri. R.A. Sampathkumaracharya (Arakere family) and Alamelamma in 1924 or so. He had his elder brother Sri M. Narasimha Iyengar (who worked in Mysore Iron & Steel, Bhadravathi) and four sisters, Ranganayakamma (Madakehuli), Vedamma (Palahalli), Rukmini (Jayaram) and Janakamma (Unguram). He had two sons, Rangarajan (ONGC), Sampathkumar (Kanva Industries), and three daughters, Kousalya (Guttahalli), Andal (Makaram) and Sriranganayaki (Kope).

His seven nephews (M. K. Singlachar, Chief Engineer, Mysore Sugar Mills, Mandya), Dr. S.S. Jayaram, M.A. J. Parthasarathy, M.A. Narasimha Iyengar, KEB, Kuttu, Pachu and Varadarajan) and thirteen nieces (Yeggamma, Chingu, Kamala, Radha, Rukka, Ranga, Sampath Kumari, YEgga, Ratna, Kumudavalli, Almela, Rukka, M.B. Thanga) and ten grand children (Arathi, Purnima, Deepa, Preeti, Lakshmi, Shubha, Sunetra, Swarna, Neela and Hari), all were very fond of him and used to call him Dore Mama (Akshi mama as he would sneez five times together).

He was very active till the last, and in the span of more than fifty years, he built many roads and buildings, in Mysore, Chamarajanagar, Yelandur, Ramanagaram, Chennapatna, Bangalore, even at Thalaguppa and many places. He built many Silk filatures, Mysore Silk Weaving Factory, part of NIE, Dasaprakash Hotel, Tobacco Barns at Ramanagaram, and many residential houses, some prominent buildings like Prabha Theater and Scout Headquarters at Mysore.

He was active in Mandayam Srivaishnava Sabha, he built the Mandayam Home at Mysore, was instrumental in getting sites for Mandayam Sabha and Yathiraj Mutt at Jayalakshmipuram, Mysore and did initial construction of Lord Lakshminarasimha Temple (Garbha Gruham) at Yathiraj Mutt site.

As a fitting memorial, his birth centenary was celebrated along with the Centenary celebrations of Pattabhishekam of his grand father Kuttithambi Jeeyar of Yathiraja Mutt, at Ramanuja Samskruthi Bhavana, Bangalore on 12th July 2008.
