Ramanuja, President MS Sabha, formally launched the web portal in front of a huge gathering of 150+ elders of the Mandayam community.

Upon the launch of the web portal, congratulatory messages by U Ve M. A. Lakshmithathacharya Swami, U Ve Tiru Ramanuja Swami and past president Sri M. D. Srinivasan were played to the audience. With the launch of the MS Sabha Web Portal, a long felt desire of the Mandayam community folks to have their own web portal has been fulfilled. We can now

proudly claim to have a platform wherein all the Mandayam community folks spread across the world can interact and together harness the talents of the community towards the benefit of all.

Features of MS Sabha Web Portal

With a long history of the people from the Mandayam community spreading across several centuries, it is obvious that over the years a part of our community folks have spread far and wide across the globe. On the other hand, the recent generation of youngsters have been gradually moving away from the traditional Mandayam sampradaya and adopting the modern day, jet age traditions, gadgets and evolving cultures. It's exactly at this juncture that this web portal is designed to bridge the gap between our traditional history and the futuristic next generation Mandayams. Each of the sections in this web portal has been carefully designed in order to provide our strong culture, traditions and contributions by eminent Mandayams as well as provide enough exciting features for the modern generation folks to experience some of

the latest practices and culture desired by youth. Read on for details.

The Home Page

This page will be the most active part of the portal and it will be our endeavour to keep this constantly updated with the latest happenings across the Mandayam community. The Home page, also being the first entry point for all users, we intend to provide certain key information about achievers from our community in various spheres of life. For example, "Meet a Mandayam" will be one such feature wherein we will

pick one achiever and This space will be utilized to cover the maximum of Mandayam achievers on a queue basis. Gradually we intend to add more variants to this feature through another series, to be named as "Tribute to **a Mandayam**". Here we intend to invite community to provide previous generation who

The Home page also has the provision for users to register themselves and take advantage of participating in certain features that are restricted to authorized users. Features like "Ask Guru", "Mandayam Virtual Mall", "Blogs/ Discussion Forums" would allow only registered, Mandayam community folks to participate. We may bring more features under this category later.

The "Mandayam Origins" and the "Mandayam **Gothras**" provide a whole lot of information tracing our origin way back to year 1053 and also how our families have evolved under various gothras. Users browsing this section can trace the history of their family as related to their gothras. There is more that needs to be added and as and when we get updates, we will enhance the information.

The "Vision & Values" of Mandayam Srivaishnava Sabha had been captured from some of the documents prepared by the vision committee. You will find a link between the key values of the vision and various sections of the web

portal since the portal is a vehicle to drive the vision goals. Click on the details box to get a full view of each of the values and also how goals are being defined.

The "*Mandayam Sabha*" section takes you back to the history of Mandayam Srivaishnava Sabha, how it evolved, who were the key sponsors from the community because of them the Sabha survived and flourished. The list of past presidents/secretaries starting from the year 1915 will surely evoke nostalgic feelings to elders in our community. Finally, the information brings you back to the present when the latest general body meeting and the first elections were formally held on 15th August, 2009.

The Religious Section

Information related to religious activities, both historic as well as the present happenings, are collated and presented in a structured format in this section. We have provided information on the birth of "Sri Ramanuja Sanskruthi Bhavan", how this extended to the formation of Yathiraja Ramanuja Trust and further Sri Yathiraja Ramanuja Sampathkumara Jeeyar, the then Peethadhipathi, was designated as the patron of the Trust. The Mathadhipathi agreed to lease the vacant land adjacent to the present Yathiraja Mutt for a period of 30 years.

The section on "**Pilgrimage Places**" delves into the history of the most respected temple by Mandayam Iyengars; the *Melkote Temple*. Other important pilgrimage places covered include the *Kere Thondanur, Sri*

Manikarnika Gunja Sri Lakshmi Narasimha Temple - Sthala Puranam

At Melkote temple the main deity or moolavar is Tirunarayana with unique presence of Lakshmi, both in his chest and at feet (Varanandi), in Girbagriha. In the immediate court yard before Girbagriha, to the left side is the shrine of processional deity – Utsavar

Shelvapillai - accompanied by Sridevi and Bhudevi. On circambulating, one sees Sudarshana Alwar followed by the consort Yadugiri nayaki's shrine. Shelvanayaki, consort of utsava moorthy graces the Thayar Sannidhi. Further ahead is Acharya Ramanuja's Sannidhi. He is the king of Melkote and is popularly known as talking Ramanuja.

A separate section in **Kannada** has been introduced that talks of some important information about



"Gnanamantapa Kshetra Charitre", about "Sri Lakshmijanardhana Devasthana" and about "Sadguru Sri Thyagarajara Amrita Vani".

The Community Section

A very interesting section which caters to a wide variety of information about the various practices and sampradaya

followed by the Mandayam community folks. Here are a brief summary of the categorization of information in the Community section:

- The List of Festivals followed by the Mandayam Srivaishnava Community covers around 28 important festivals that are of significance. As we settle down with the full web portal in a later stage, we intend to gradually provide more information about all the festivals including possible dates, key features etc. We request community folks to provide us with more information about these which we could upload after due verification.
- The Method of Serving Festival Food is an interesting short article that explains the reasons for serving certain items in a particular sequence as well as which side of the leaf the items are typically served.
- A write-up on the *Importance of Gayatri Mantra* makes interesting reading and is very informative too.
- Quite often we wonder how big is the Mandayam community that is spread across the globe. This table about the list of *Mandayam Srivaishnava Families* is very useful for us to get the big picture. We understand that the information keeps changing dynamically and will try to get updates periodically. Please do share your family information to help us with updates.
- A special section dedicated to the great Mandayams of the past who made us all proud has been compiled in the section "Tribute to Great Mandayam Personalities". Dating way back to the year 1863 onwards interesting information about some of the great Mandayam personalities including G. G. Narasimhachar, M. A. Narayana Iyengar, Prof. M. Rangachar Rao

Bahadur, The Puducheri Brothers and R. Narasimhachar Rao Bahadur have been enumerated. We are aware that there are many other great Mandayam personalities who do not figure in this list, only due to lack of available information. A set of panel members will be identified for each Guru category and their credentials will be uploaded for all to view. Any query raised in a particular category will be communicated to the panel of Gurus, feedback obtained and uploaded on the Web Portal for all to view. We have currently identified a few Gurus in couple categories and are looking forward to nominations from community folks about other Gurus in various categories. The DIY Section

Do-It-Yourself (DIY): There are a number of situations wherein an individual felt that if only a self help procedure for doing a particular activity is available, it would be great. This DIY section will attempt to identify such activities and provide help. For example; Gayatri Mantra Japam, Changing Punol, Reciting Vishnu Sahasranamam etc. could be a few starters. The DIY could be extended to other areas like preparing food items which are Mandyam special like *Iyengar Puliyogere*, *Paal Payasam* etc. We intend to categorize the DIY items into Religious, Cooking, travel, Music, General and many more.
