The Annual Mandayam Meet 2017

The Annual meet of Mandayams which the Sabha organizes every year is a great draw in the community as it provides the opportunity for the community members to meet and interact with each other. So, as it happens every year, members were very anxiously looking forward to the various events under our annual meet. We bring you a brief report on the various events that were held under the Mandayam Annual Meet 2017

Shuttle badminton held on 07.10.2017 at Canara Union





The inaugural event of this year's Annual Meet was Shuttle Badminton, which was held on 7 th October 2017, at Prakash Padukone Courts, at Canara Union, Malleswaram, Bengaluru. A new feature this year was the introduction of 'Online Registration' for participants. The response was very good and there were in all 104 participants. About 79 participants had registered 'on line', of whom 72 attended. There were around 32 on-the-spot registrations. Another new feature introduced this year was a registration fee of Rs. 50/- from each participant. The amount collected was utilized to meet the day's expenses towards refreshments, lunch and tea.

The game was classified into the following categories:

- 1. Sub junior Boys and Girls up to 10 years, Singles format
- 2. Junior Boys and Girls- 11 to 20 age group, Singles format
- 3. Youth, Men and women- 21 to 40 age group, Doubles format
- 4. Seniors, Men and Women in the age group 41 to 65 (Doubles only)
- 5. Veterans, Men and Women, 65 years and above (Singles only)
- 6. Mixed Doubles

The event was inaugurated by Sri. Mathre Rangarajan, one of the Senior Members of the Sabha, in the presence of the President Sri. Sheshnarayan and the Secretary Sri. M.T. Ravi Narasimhan. The games were played in 3 courts starting with Sub-junior category and it went on till 7.30 in the evening. The games were keenly contested and played with great enthusiasm. All the contestants played the game in a fair manner, combining fun and fervour. There were many women participants





in all categories. Among the winners, Anagha in the Sub-juniors singles category and Runner up in the mixed doubles; and Ashwin in the Junior boys singles category and Winner in the mixed doubles, deserve special mention for their exemplary game.

An update on MVN - Mysore

Dear Mandayams,

The building of new MVN complex which started off in 2013 got completed in 2016. There were some civil works required to be done as per tenants' requirements which added to the costs. Despite intense efforts by the committe members to get tenants, occupancy was for only half of the building during entire 2017. Only from April 2018 one more portion is getting occupied. With this 2/3rd portion will have tenancy with total rental revenue of approx Rs 2.25 lacs per month from April 2018. Still entire first floor of approx 4250 sq feet is available for rent. We request everyone to put in efforts to get tenants for the same. Due to this the repayment schedule of the depositors which was earlier worked out as 8 years may be delayed for a couple of years more.

Letters to depositors were sent out after a meeting of depositors with various options and we are thankful to all the depositors for their patience and magnanimity .

Out of a total of 256 depositors, 14 depositors with amount totalling to Rs 12 lakhs have converted their deposits into donations, 61 depositors have agreed for repayment of principal only, 72 depositors have waived off interest till June 2018 and thereafter interest @6%, and rest have agreed to the original terms. We respect the individual decisions and once again thank all the depositors for having reposed faith in the committee members and the Sabha .

Samaja Sudharaka Swami Ramanuja



On Saturday, 3rd February 2018, Palalli Narayana Iyengar Charities and the Kala Premi Foundation, jointly presented a program titled "Samaja Sudharaka Swami Ramanuja", featuring the social reformer facet of Ramanujacharya, based on instances from his life. This was presented in the divine presence of H H Sri Sri Yadugiri Yathiraja Narayana Ramanuja Jeeyar Swami, at the Seva Sadan auditorium. It was a novel audio visual presentation along with music, dance and narration.

The life of Ramanujacharya is full of incidences which show his concern for all, regardless of caste, creed or gender. He firmly believed that everyone has the opportunity to seek salvation and realize God. He broke the barriers of caste, and high and low births and propagated that all are equally entitled to reach out to the Supreme Being. He gave the honorific title of 'Tirukulattar' to the so called "untouchables" and allowed them entry to the temple. When he was taught the secret of 'Ashtakshari' mantra which would lead one to salvation and was told by his Guru not to disclose it to any

one, he climbed the tower of the temple there, called everyone in the town and taught them the secret mantra. The Guru was furious on learning this. But Ramanuja said he would not mind going to hell if so many could attain salvation by reciting the mantra. Such was the concern of Ramanuja for the welfare of his fellow beings. The presentation showcased many such anecdotes from Ramanuja's life which highlighted his compassion and concern for social welfare.

The artists of Sri Godhadevi Sangam presented this program, which was highly appreciated by the audience. The narration was brought out in the form of a booklet which was released by Jeeyar Swami and was distributed to all the members of the audience. The Jeeyar Swami in his talk touched upon the learnings that we get from the various instances in the life of Ramanujacharya. He lauded the efforts of the organizers and the artists in bringing this home to the audience in an effective manner.

What is Good Luck

When someone or something is successful, we often hear people telling how lucky the person was or how lucky it was and conversely, if something doesn't succeed then it is attributed to bad luck. Based on this line of thinking, we also tend to group people as the lucky ones and the unlucky ones. The lucky people are almost always successful, while the unlucky ones are unsuccessful most of the times. The belief in luck is such a strong influence on the human mind that people tend to identify many things with good luck or bad luck, like the days of the week, colours, dresses, numbers, etc. Many go to great lengths to acquire good luck or improve their luck through charms, talismans, taviz, etc. If this factor called 'luck' plays such an important role in our lives, should we not know more about it? Has anybody done a scientific study on it? Yes, Prof. Richard Wiseman, a psychologist from the University of Hampshire in UK has done some research on this subject and his findings are very interesting

Some years ago, Prof. Wiseman wanted to investigate luck. He wanted to examine as to what impact does chances or opportunities, lucky breaks, or being in the right place at the right time, have on people's lives. After many preliminary experiments, he believed that he had got some understanding as to why some people are luckier than others and that it is possible for one to become luckier. So, to commence his study, he placed advertisements in national newspapers and magazines, asking for people who felt consistently lucky or unlucky, to contact him. In course of time, about 400 men and women volunteered for participating in his research. They were from all walks of life and their ages ranged from 18 to 84 years - the youngest being a 18 year old student and the oldest being an 84-year-old retired accountant.

Among the volunteers from the 'Lucky' group, Jessica, a 42-year-old forensic scientist was a typical example. She explained "I have my dream job, two wonderful children and a great guy whom I love very much. It's amazing; when I look back at my life, I realise I have been lucky in just about everything."

In contrast, a typical example of the 'unlucky' group was Carolyn, a 34-year-old care assistant. She was accident-prone. In one week, she twisted her ankle in a pothole, injured her back in another fall and reversed her car into a tree during a driving lesson. She was also unlucky in love and felt she was always in the wrong place at the wrong time.

Prof. Wiseman interviewed these volunteers, asked them to complete diaries, questionnaires

and intelligence tests, and invited them to participate in experiments. The findings reveal that while the unlucky people have almost no insight into the real causes of their good and bad luck, their thoughts, behaviour and attitude are responsible for much of their fortune.

Prof Wiseman has identified the four basic principles adopted by the lucky people, which is useful to create good fortune in their lives. They have a positive attitude and believe strongly that they will be successful.

Principle 1: Maximise Chances or Opportunities

Lucky people are skilled at creating, noticing and acting upon chances and opportunities. They do this in various ways, including networking, adopting a relaxed attitude to life and by being open to new experiences.

Principle 2: Listening to Lucky Hunches Lucky people make effective decisions by listening to their intuition and gut feelings. In addition, they take steps to boost their intuitive abilities by, clearing their mind of other thoughts and focusing on the job on hand.

Principle 3: Expect Good Fortune

Lucky people are certain that the future is going to be full of good fortune. These expectations become self-fulfilling prophecies by helping lucky people persist in the face of failure, and shape their interactions with others in a positive way.

Principle 4: Turn Bad Luck to Good

Lucky people employ various psychological techniques to cope with, and often even thrive upon, the ill fortune that comes their way. For example, they spontaneously imagine how things could have been worse; do not dwell on misfortune, and take control of the situation.

Prof Wiseman's research also examined the effect of thinking and behaving like a lucky person. The effectiveness of the techniques his research developed have been scientifically tested in a series of experiments in what he refers to as 'luck school'. This project has been highly successful, with almost all participants reporting significant life changes, including increased levels of luck, self-esteem, confidence and success.

Prof. Wiseman says that lucky people consistently take notice of chances and Opportunities they come across, whereas unlucky people do not. He tells us about a simple experiment that he carried out, which brings out this aspect. He gave both lucky and unlucky people participating in his experiment a newspaper, and asked them to go through it and tell how many photographs were in it. On an average, the unlucky people took about two

minutes to count the photographs, whereas the lucky people took just seconds. The reason? Because, the second page of the newspaper contained a bold message: "Stop counting. There are 43 photographs in this newspaper." This message covered half of the page and was written in letters larger than 2 inches in height. It was staring everyone right in the face. The unlucky people tended to miss it out, while the lucky ones tended to spot it. Further, he had placed a similar large message halfway through the newspaper saying: "Stop counting. Tell the experimenter you have seen this and win £250." Again, the unlucky people missed the opportunity because they were still too busy looking for photographs.

Personality tests revealed that unlucky people are generally much tenser than lucky people, and research has shown that anxiety disrupts people's ability to notice the unexpected. The following experiment illustrates this phenomenon. In the experiment, people were asked to watch a moving dot in the centre of a computer screen. Without warning, large dots would occasionally be flashed at the edges of the screen. Nearly all participants noticed these large dots.

The experiment was then repeated with a second group of people, who were offered a large financial reward for accurately watching the dot at the centre, thus creating some anxiety in them. They became so focused on the dot at the centre that more than a third of them missed the large dots when they appeared on the screen. The harder they looked, the less they saw.

It works the same way with luck. The unlucky people miss chance opportunities because they are too focused on looking for something else. They look through newspapers determined to find certain types of job advertisements and as a result miss other types of jobs. Lucky people are more relaxed and open, and therefore see what is there rather than just what they are looking for The research revealed that lucky people are skilled at creating and noticing chance opportunities, make lucky decisions by listening to their intuition, create self-fulfilling prophesies via positive expectations, and adopt a resilient attitude that transforms bad luck into good.

Wondering if these four principles could be used to increase the amount of good luck that one encounters in one's life, Prof. Wiseman tried to find out if one's luck can be enhanced by getting one to think and behave like a lucky person. He designed certain exercises which help one to spot opportunities, listen to intuition, expect to be lucky and be more resilient to bad luck; and asked a group of lucky and unlucky volunteers to spend a month carrying out exercises. One month later, the

volunteers returned and described what had happened. The results were dramatic: 80 per cent of people were now happier, more satisfied with their lives and, perhaps most important of all, luckier.

Based on his study, Prof. Wiseman suggests the following steps to improve one's good fortune:

- Unlucky people often fail to follow their intuition when making a choice, whereas lucky people tend to respect hunches. Lucky people are interested in how they both think and feel about the various options, rather than simply looking at the rational side of the situation. I think this helps them, because gut feelings act as an alarm bell - a reason to consider a decision carefully.
- Unlucky people tend to be creatures of routine. They tend to take the same route to and from work and talk to the same types of people at parties. In contrast, many lucky people try to introduce variety into their lives. For example, one person described how he thought of a colour before arriving at a party and then introduced himself to people wearing that colour. This kind of behavior boosts the likelihood of chance opportunities by introducing variety.
- Lucky people tend to see the positive side of their ill fortune. They imagine how things could have been worse. In one interview, a lucky volunteer arrived with his leg in a plaster cast and described how he had fallen down a flight of stairs. I asked him whether he still felt lucky and he cheerfully explained that he felt luckier than before. As he pointed out, he could have broken his neck.

So, good luck is a matter of positive thinking and attitude. A matter of faith in yourself and believing that you will do it.

An accomplished Veena player and an 'A grade' artist of the AIR, Rajalakshmi was born in 1935 in Bangalore, India. Rajalakshmi gave her first performance at the age of thirteen in the presence of the then Maharaja, His Highness Sri Jayachamarajendra Wodeyar of Mysore. Since then she has been giving many solo performances in India and overseas, and was also the recipient of the Karnataka Rajyotsava award, among many other laurels conferred on her. Inauguration of Mandayam Sabha's office at Mysore


