Take big palak leaf apply the bajji Batter one layer in inner side of the leaf and keep a veg balls and roll it. Prik the roll with tooth pick. Dip it in batter fry it in oil. Serve with green chutney and sweet chutney.

1. Sweet Potato (Boiled and Smashed) Finely
2. Kobbari (grated)
3. Jaggery Powder

5. Cashew (small pieces)

For Covering:-

1. Chiroti Rava
2. Maida (1 spoon)
3. Ghee (Make dough with Chiroti Rava, Ghee and Maida put a pan on the stove with low flame.

Put ghee and mashed potato, Jaggery powder, kobbari cardamom, stir well till the purnam becomes soft. Then make obbattu on thava without oil. Make the obbattu on low flame.

ENDOWMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

The Mandayam Srivaishnava Sabha's Central Committee under the presidentship of Sri Natampally Narasimhan had formed a sub-committee in 2012 to oversee the endowment receipts and distribution of its funds received by the members in the memory of their elders.

The Committee formed is as follows: *Chairperson:* Smt. Indira Parthasarathy. *Ex-Officio Members:* President: Sri N. Narasimhan Vice-President: Kum. M.B. Thanga Secretary: Sri M.D. Jayasimha Joint Secretary : Sri M.K. Srinivasan Treasurer: Sri M.A. Ramprasad. *Co-opted Members:* Sri M.D. Srivas Schar, Sri R.M. Srinivasan, Sri M.R. Krishna.

The first meeting was held on 3rd December 2012 at the Sabha office. It was then decided that the committee members should scrutinise the applications of different categories and distribute the amount on a fixed date.

A minimum of 80% for graduates and 65% for post graduates was fixed as cut off point for eligibility to receive merit awards. The committee also agreed to accept donations on a yearly basis. Financial assistance is given to the following categories:

1. Education - Rs. 3,000/- per person.
2. Financial assistance to the needy - Rs. 2,500/- per person.
3. Handicapped - Rs. 3,500 per person.
4. Merit awards for SSLC, PUC, Graduate and Post Graduate students.
5. Medical Assistance.

In addition to the above categories honorarium was given to children to encourage shloka recital and learning. Vaidikas were also given honorarium in recognition of their services to the community as and when received.

A few weeks ago, under the project namea 'A Thousand Smiling Faces' around 19 students accumulated funds through an online crowd-funding website. They gathered around Rs 1 lakh. "We began collecting money around eight days ago. After several Facebook posts, two blog entires, emails and hours spent walking from house to house asking people to donate, we managed to raise over Rs 1,00,000. The meals themselves cost us Rs 86,500 (McDonald's gave us a 20 per cent discount on the grounds that it was charity), which leaves us with approximately Rs 10,000. I intend to use the Rs 10,000 to do another set of deliveries after January 16 once my exams are finished," says Ritwik, a 10-grade student of Vidya Nikethan School. The idea for this initiative was planned when Ritwik had volunteered to work in an NGO which inspired him to work towards this cause.

RPAC, Melkote

An analysis of RPAC's occupancy/incomes indicates a higher contribution from bulk occupation by University groups/college students coming on tour as part of their curriculum, compared to individual bookings. As there are only 9 rooms with attached bath/toilet and no provision of common toilet, when large groups of nearly 40 students arrive at a time, there is a great deficit of toilet and bathing facilities.
