All the Saturdays and Sundays of the month of December 2007 was full of competitions where many members of our community participated and enjoyed with fun. It was more of a social gathering for members to meet and interact.

The finale of all the activities concluded on Sunday, the 30th December 2007, coinciding with the Founder's Day. The programme at Sri Ramanuja Samskriti Bhavana started at 9.15 am with Fancy Dress Competition. This was a very attractive event where many members competed including children below 6 years. The audience enjoyed the different fancy dresses, particularly of the children below 6 years.

The cultural programme started with an Invocation by Vidushis M. A. Meera and M.A. Mythili, daughters of Sangeetha Kalanidhi, Sangeetha Bhushana (Late) M.A. Narasimhachar, popularly known as M.A. Shamasunder in Mandayam Community. The Invocation included a slokam on Lord Krishna followed by a song on Lord Krishna in the Raag Jayanthi Shree composed by Mysore Vasudevacharya.

Sri M.D. Ramanuja, President of the Sabha welcomed the members and in his speech congratulated all the participants and organisers in various activities for their co-operation extended. He requested the members to keep up the same tempo throughout and make every programme of the Sabha successful.

Kum. M.A. Seetha, Vice-President, read a brief report of the activities conducted during December 2007.

PRESENT NEGLECT MAKES FUTURE REGRET.

“The Mandayam Srivaishnava Sabha is organising programmes like Sri Thyagaraja Aradhana, Sri Ramanujacharya Thirunaksha-thram, Adivellikkilamai and Socials every year. Besides these, the Sabha has decided to celebrate Founder’s Day every year. This year from 1st December 2007 to 23rd December 2007, Indoor competitions like clay modelling, painting, cookery, Stotra Ratna, Rangoli, Hand Embroidery, Pot painting and vegetable carving were arranged on all Saturdays in Sri Yadugiri Yathiraja Mutt and Outdoor games like Volleyball, Basket Ball, Cricket and field events were conducted on all Sundays at various play grounds. The response by our members was very good. Bangalore has developed very large and our community families have spread out all over and it is very difficult to reach the venues on time. To enable the members to come on time without wasting time to cook at home, the Sabha had arranged sponsors to provide breakfast and lunch for all the members. Sri M. K. Varadan, Smt. Mekhala and Sri Sanjay, Smt. Geetha and Dr. (Vet) M. A. Srinivasan, Smt. Jayachar provided breakfast and lunch on all the days of Major Games. The Central Committee takes lot of interest to have more competitors (children, youth, adults, senior citizens) for competitions by posting and distributing more than 900 pamphlets, but the response is not much encouraging. It is observed that the enthusiasm and interest shown by the senior citizens in all competitions was not found in our jubilant youth. Here I fail in my report if I don’t mention with pride a few senior citizens like Smt. Jaya Nayakan, aged about 70 participated in Rangoli and the design was so symmetrical and perfect which any youngster cannot write without a foot rule and compasses. This is really an example for all of us to follow his footsteps with courage and boldness.

The unsung heroines of our epics, a unique feature programmed and presented by Smt. Geetha Alwar, where 19 ladies and one boy adorned the roles and dresses of few selected heroines of Ramayana and Mahabharata attracted the audience.

“The main character in the Ramayana and the Mahabharata are very famous. Every one knows about them. However, there are many other heroes and heroines in our epics

who are not so well known. They have also played important roles, but they have not been given due prominence in our art and literature. Most people are ignorant of their true greatness. Inspired by Ammangar Goda, Smt. Geetha Alwar gave a programme in which six unsung heroines selected from each epic were portrayed. The essential character of each heroine was brought out by acting the respective part in appropriate setting according to the script written by Ammangar Goda which was read out in the background. Each heroine was just according to the region to which she belonged to. Thus there were twelve different type of dresses, hairstyle, jewellery and other ornamentation according to their region and social status. Different pieces of classical music was provided by Col. Sri S. ALASINGRACHAR (S.A. CHAR)



The Institution of Engineers (India), Mysore Centre felicitating Sri S. Alasingrachar

Sri S. Alasingrachar (S.A. Char) is a Mysorean. He is the son of Late S. Narasimhan - Mathematics teacher. He graduated in Civil Engineering from Mysore University in 1959 and did his Master of Engg. from IIT, New Delhi.

Shri Char was a UN Fellow in Australia with the Snowy-Mountains Authority and was on Foreign Assignment as Project Manager with the Kaduna State Water Board in Nigeria for 5 years, where he successfully executed a drinking water supply project for a large town. He has participated in several National and International Conferences in India and abroad and has published over 50 technical papers. He has travelled widely in Europe, USA, Canada, Japan and South East Asia. He has worked in various positions like Director and Chief Engineer in the Central Water Commission. He has been associated with the planning, designs and construction of over twenty-five water resources projects in different parts of India. These include hydroelectric as well as drinking water supply and irrigation projects. He was a member of the working group on Technology of construction set up by the planning commission and was Vice-Chairman, National Advisory Committee on Research and Development for hydraulic structures. He has been a Director of Board of Directors of Water and Power Consultancy Services and Triveni Structurals Ltd.

He was chairman of the Narmada Canals Committee (World's Biggest Irrigation Canal) and was member of Sardar Sarovar Dam (2nd largest Dam in the World) Construction Advisory Committee.

He has over 40 years of experience in the field of water resources development and river basin management. He retired in the rank of Additional Secretary to the Govt. of India in the Ministry of Water Resources and was associated in the implementation of a large number of Water Resources Projects in the country. As the Executive Head of the Narmada Control Authority, he dealt with interstate aspects of the Basin States (Gujarat, MP, Maharashtra, Rajasthan).

He has been working as Water Resources Management Adviser with SMEC (International) and has been adviser to WAPCOS, Bangalore, where he was associated with the preparation of detailed project reports for water supply and sewerage systems for 7 CMCs & 1 TMC of Greater Bangalore. Independently, he has carried out consultancy works for Karnataka Urban Water Supply & Drainage Board for Water Supply to Bidar, Belgaum, Moodigere, Moodbidri, Dharmastala etc. He was also associated with the Rural Water Supply Programme in Karnataka being implemented with World Bank assistance. His paper on Future Approach towards Water Resources Development has been incorporated with the proceedings of the World Commission on Dams, which is now a part of UNEP.

Shri S.A. Char has been a Member of the Apex Council for Water Supply and Sanitation set up by the Government of Karnataka. Presently he is a Director of the Board of Cauvery Neeravari Nigama, Govt. of Karnataka and is associated with Modernization of Cauvery basin projects.

His proposal to renovate the Sacred Tonnur Tank and Mouni Narayana Temple, Venugopalaswamy Temple with landscaping, to develop Tonnur as a beauty spot and pilgrimage centre at a cost of Rs. 2.5 crore has been accepted and he is implementing the project.

MANDAYAM ALASINGA PERUMAL (1963-1909)

Vivekananda's devoted dedicated disciple down South

Of the innumerable disciples that Swami Vivekananda had all over India, there were a few disciples whom Swamiji always remembered with gratitude for the assistance and service rendered to him in sponsoring his trip to Chicago to attend the Parliament of World Religions in September 1893. Mandayam Alasinga Perumal from Madras was one such disciple who was one of the most ardent admirers of the Swamiji. Alasinga, the name by which Swamiji used to address Perumal affectionately, was the foremost in making house to house collection of funds in Madras to arrange for Swamiji's expenses to go to Chicago. Remembering Alasinga's help with gratitude, Swami Vivekananda has written:

“One rarely finds men like our Alasinga in the world - One who is so unselfish, so hardworking and so devoted to his Guru. Such an obedient disciple is very rare on earth”.

It is well known that Swamiji was in deep meditation for three days on the Vivekananda Rock near Kanyakumari in December 1892 where he had a great vision of the future of the country and came to certain conclusions of what he should do to the country and how. With tears in his eyes and hope in his breast, he discovered his mission in life, which was to dedicate himself to the regeneration of India. It was here he took a firm decision to attend the Parliament of Religions at Chicago and blazon forth the magnificence of our Sanathana Dharma to the West. When Alasinga Perumal heard about this, he felt that it was a fine opportunity for the entire country to send Vivekananda to Chicago and that no efforts should be spared to miss such an opportunity. Immediately he collected a few close associates of his and a subscription Committee was formed to raise sufficient funds to sponsor the trip to Chicago. The members went from door to door collecting money, a thing that had never happened in Madras. It appears that they were able to collect nearly Rs. 3,000 within four days. Besides the efforts of the Subscription Committee, there were other philanthropists like the Maharaja of Mysore, the Raja of Ramanad, and Khetri Maharaja etc. who helped the noble cause voluntarily. Finally, Swamiji set for United States from Bombay on 31st May 1893 by the P&O Steamer Peninsular. Alasinga was at the Port to see Swamiji off.

Recollecting the efforts of his young disciples from Madras in making him go to Chicago, Swamiji in one of the letters said *“The Madras people have done for me more than I deserved and more than was in their power. My thanks eternal to the Madras young men, led by Alasinga.”* Again in a letter to Swami Abhedananda in October 1895, Vivekananda writes *“In effect Mr. Sterdy is my Secretary in England, Mahendra Bapu in Calcutta and Alasinga in Madras”.* When Vivekananda was in the United States, among the many letters which he wrote, forty of them were addressed to “Alasinga”. In a glorious tribute to Alasinga, Subramanya Bharatiyar has said *“Alasinga was one of the chief disciples of Swamiji. When in 1893 Vivekananda came to the South like any of the wandering mendicants, it was Alasinga Perumal who discovered the splendour of Vivekananda and brought glory to the nation.”*

Swamiji wrote several letters from America to some of his close disciples in India. In all these, he stressed the importance and the power of journalism as a powerful tool in spreading the tenets of our Sanathana Dharma, in addition to building up an effective organization. In a letter from New York dated 25th September 1894, he expressed a desire to start a magazine in Sanskrit and one in Hindi, in addition to a magazine in English. His young disciples from Madras took up the clue and as was expected, Alasinga took the initiative in starting an English magazine in response to Swamiji's desire. He discussed this issue with a few close associates, formed a committee and prepared and published a prospectus for the new journal. A relevant paragraph of the prospectus said:

INNER WORTH IS BETTER THAN OUTER SHOW.

“Under the advice and with the encouragement of Swami Vivekananda, it is proposed to start a weekly journal to be named **“Brahmavadin”**. The main object of the journal is to propagate the principles of the Vedantic religion of India and to work towards the improvement of the social and moral conditions of man by holding aloft the sublime and universal ideal of Hinduism.” **Brahmavadin** could not appear as a weekly as noted in the prospectus but came out as a fortnightly. The first issue was dated 14th September 1895 and was issued from Triplicane, Madras. It had 14 pages and its first editor was Alasinga Perumal.

Swamiji got many people to subscribe to the ‘Brahmavadin’, wrote articles to the paper and offered guidance and advice. In a letter written to Alasinga Perumal, Swamiji gave the following advice on the style that he must adopt: “You must always remember that you are addressing the whole world, not India alone, and that the same world is entirely ignorant about what you have to tell them. Use the translations of every Sanskrit shloka very carefully and make things as easy as possible”. Thus **Brahmavadin** became the first voice of the Swamiji to be followed by the **Prabuddha Bharata** in 1896.

Apart from the magazine, the Brahmavadin Company, founded by Alasinga Perumal, also started publishing some selected books under the title **“Brahmavadin Series”**. The first of the series was **‘Karma Yoga’** which was published in 1896 and contained the lectures that Swamiji delivered in New York between December 1895 and January 1896. The book was priced and sold at one anna (1/16th of a rupee). In September 1896, the Brahmavadin published **‘The Ideal of Universal Religion’** which was a lecture delivered by the Swamiji in America and was priced at one rupee. In 1897, two more books were published namely, **‘Six Madras Lectures of the Swamiji’** and the book **‘From Colombo to Almora - Seventeen Lectures’**.

It can be observed from the above these lectures in the form of a book were brought out within three to four months of their delivery in America at an incredibly astonishing speed. Given the fact that about 120 years back, communication and printing technology were in their infancy.

Sri Perumal passed away in Madras on 11th May 1909.

Grind onions, green chillies, ginger and coriander leaves together. Add coconut and grind to make a smooth paste.

Heat oil in a kadai, add Jeera.

When golden brown, add ground paste.

Now fry till the oil separates out.

Add salt to taste.

Add the cooked rice (cold) to kadai and mix.

Serve hot with raita.

Note:

According to season, add fresh boiled and salted green peas to improve taste.

For increasing appetite, decorate with golden brown cashews.

CHINESE VADA

Padmashree Uday
Cooked Rice, Second Prize

Ingredients required:

Rice flour, corn flour, chiroti rava, dalda, carrot, cabbage, onion, coriander leaves, salt, green chillies, ajinomoto, oil for frying

Measurement:

Rice flour	1 cup
Corn flour	1/4 cup
Chiroti Rava	1/2 cup
Carrot	1/4 Kg.
Cabbage	1/4 Kg
Onion	2
Ajinomoto	a pinch

Method:

Fry the rice flour, corn flour, chiroti rava together in a dry pan for sometime. Remove this from the flame and add dalda (a bit), grated carrot, cabbage, onion, coriander leaves, ajinomoto, green chillies to the above flour. Add required quantity of water, salt to taste and make the dough. Roll this into required shape and deep fry in oil.

Have this with tomato sauce.

Fried Rice, Second Prize

Ingredients

1 cup mixed sprouts
1 boiled potato
1/2 cup rice flour
1 tsp green chilli and ginger paste
1 tsp garam masala or tandoori masala
Coriander leaves a few
Salt to taste
Lime juice (optional)

Method:

Steam cook the mixed sprouts and coarsely grind them. Add boiled and mashed potato, ginger chilli paste, rice flour and all powdered masalas. Add coriander leaves. Mix and shape like kababs (oval or round) and deep fry. This can also be shallow fried on the tava. Serve HOT with chutney or sauce of your choice.
